



HIGH FIVE

SHADOWING PROGRAM

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The program offers up to 10 pre-med students the opportunity to shadow physicians from five different specialties. High Five aligns with the institution's AMCAS workshop, which was developed to assist prospective students with submitting a competitive medical school application. The program dates and times are determined by the partnering physician.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 3.5 GPA
- Minimum MCAT score of 500
- Louisiana resident

PROCESS:

- Prospective students interested in the High Five program need to contact Kambry Ford, the OSCE program manager, via email: kambry.ford@lsuhs.edu.
- A prospective student will complete the High Five Application by the specified deadline.
- The prospective student will receive email notification from the OSCE's program manager of their acceptance into the High Five.
- The Assistant Vice Chancellor for Student and Community Engagement (OCSE) will work to identify five physicians to commit time and effort to this program.

EXPECTED OUTCOME:

- The prospective student will apply to the LSU Health Shreveport medical education program.
- The prospective medical student will enroll in the LSU Health Shreveport medical education program.
